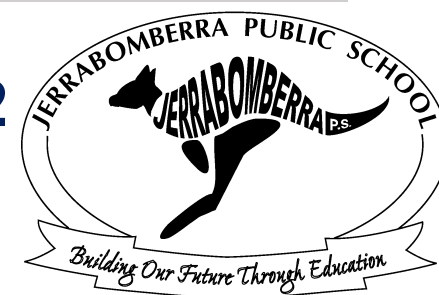


Home Learning Plan – Kindergarten – Term 2 Week 2

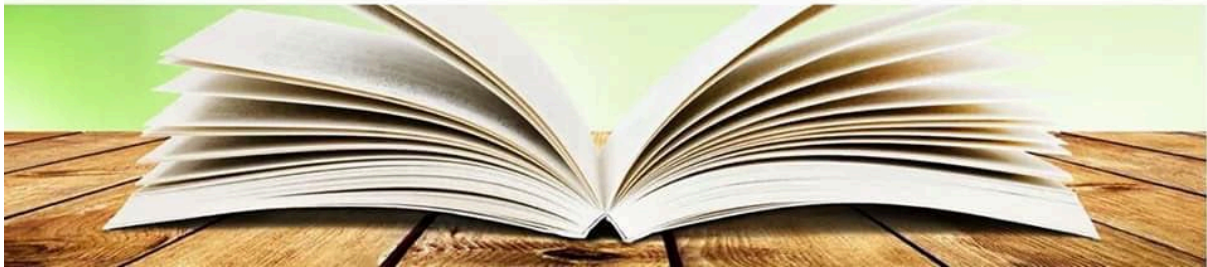
